




Brief Overview of the program

- Training of teachers for all 365 Schools with ATLs is being organised with support from Intel & IBM
- 2 teachers from each school will attend the training
- Training will happen at 10 hub ATLs across the country managed by Intel
- In all there will be 23+ workshops over a course of 4 months August, September, October, November
- Every training session will be of 5 days



Brief about Unbox Tinkering Workshop Program

- Teacher training workshops are being organised for teachers from all schools with ATLs. The objective is to orient the teachers and provide them with the know-how to become the enablers for the entire process and journey of tinkering in schools.
- Every School with ATL
 - has to ensure participation of teachers in the training
 - has to nominate 2 teachers for training using the following criteria
 - has to ensure that the nominated teachers reach the training venue in time and attend all 5 days of the training.
- All the expenses of the teachers (travel, boarding & lodging) will need to be taken care of by their school under the NITI Aayog – ATL grant as per the government norms

Teacher nomination criteria


The ATL In-charge teacher can be one of the teachers nominated for the 5 day training. Suggested criteria for nominating teachers for training are –

- Enthusiastic and willing to learn and make things
- Proficient in English as well as the local language
- Strong interest in working with young people aged 12-18 years
- Possesses strong interpersonal and life skills
- Understands the importance of working in collaboration
- Is interested in electronics, computers, and physics
- Prior expertise with technical and STEM subject matter would be a plus
- Strong drive to help young people build skills, confidence and an opportunity to do something new and out of the box
- Has passion to innovate and a tendency to drive curiosity
- Previous experience of tinkering, technology, computers, and physics would be beneficial



Brief about Unbox Tinkering Workshop Program

- Each of the ATL schools has been mapped to one of the ten training venues; the selected/ nominated teachers are required to go online on Niti Aayog's website and book a batch –http://niti.gov.in/
- All the schools get to nominate and send 2 teachers from their school to attend the training.
- For every training batch at every training venue the number of seats available are fixed and will be available on first come first basis. Please book a batch at the earliest


